Tatopani Ghorepani Village Trekking trip is one of the most desiring programs intended for those who want to see the Himalayas, to explore the unique cultural, tradition and religion of tribes in Nepal within short period of time, a beautiful panoramic mountain view from the Poon Hill situated at the elevation of 3210m. Visiting Ghandruk rewards to have deep look of Gurung Culture and their tradition. Ghorepani and Poon Hill is the best viewpoint for panoramic view of Annapurna Himalayan range, can be easily reached from Ghorepani. This is one of the best view points in Asia. Walking through the Asia's rhododendron forest is also the unforgettable experience during the spring season. Ghandruk is a large traditional Gurung village while Ghorepani is the settlement below the famed vantage point of Poon Hill. And Chitwan Tour offers a memorable wild life experience in Nepal first National Park, home of 68 species of mammals, 544 species of birds, 56 species of herpetofauna and 126 species of fish have been recorded in the park. The park is especially renowned for its protection of One Horned Rhinoceros, Royal Bengal Tiger and Gharial Crocodile.
